



- 58% (167 of 287) of all EHS children who are up-to- date on a schedule of age-appropriate preventative and primary oral health care according to the relevant state's EPSDT schedule

Only children ages 2 and older are recommended to have a dental exam.





FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Year Ended December 31, 2021

Head Start and Early Head Start are federally funded child development programs for qualifying children under age five. Created in 1965, the federal Office of Head Start awards grants to local nonprofit organizations, such as Riverbend Head Start and Family Services, to operate programs in their communities.



The most recent financial audit was completed by CPA firm, C.J. Schlosser & Company, LLC. in Alton, Illinois in May 18, 2022 without any questioned costs. The board of Directors approved the financial audit on May 25, 2022.
